AFFIDAVIT OF DENNIS ALBANO IN SUPPORT OF DEFENDANT'S  
MOTION FOR A NEW TRIAL

I, Dennis Albano, being first duly sworn according to law, hereby say and depose the following:

1. That I make this affidavit in support of Leonard Paradiso's motion for a new trial.
2. That during or about June 1985 I had a conversation with Christine Delisi.
3. That Christine Delisi told me she had been a witness for the prosecution at the trial of Leonard Paradiso.
4. That Christine Delisi told me that she had been badgered and coerced into testifying at Paradiso's trial.
5. That Christine Delisi told me that there were criminal charges against her, or that there were going to be criminal charges brought against her.
6. That Christine Delisi did not give me specific information as to the nature of the pending, or possible to be pending in the future, criminal charges against her.
7. That Christine Delisi did tell me that the Massachusetts State Police told her that she could lose her child if the charges against her were pushed by the prosecutor's office.
8. That Christine Delisi told me that the Massachusetts State Police repeatedly called her on the telephone and visited her home until she relented and agreed to testify for the prosecution at Leonard Paradiso's trial.
