PARADISO FBI NUMBER 26759E AS PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR MURDER OF VICTIM AND MARIE IANUZZI, WHOSE BODY WAS DISCOVERED IN 1978. SUFFOLK COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, BOSTON, MASS. AND MASS. STATE POLICE WERE PROVIDED INFORMATION FROM SOURCE SINCE THEY ARE CONDUCTING IANUZZI AND WEBSTER INVESTIGATIONS. SOURCE STATED THE WEBSTER WAS TAKEN BY BOAT INTO BOSTON HARBOR WHERE SHE WAS KILLED AND BODY DUMPED INTO HARBOR. SOURCE HAS PASSED TWO POLYGRAPH EXAMINATIONS CONDUCTED BY STATE
