By way of background, victim disappeared on or about 12/5/81 while enroute from her residence in New Jersey to Smith College and Howard School of Design, Boston, Massachusetts. Local law enforcement has conducted investigation which indicates victim was last seen at Logan International Airport, Boston, Massachusetts. Her purse was found in a marsh north of Boston. Investigation also has identified at least four or five boyfriends of victim.

Attached teletype from Boston advises of investigation conducted in attempts to locate Joan Webster. Miss Webster's whereabouts remain unknown.

On 10/14/82, [redacted] received a telephone call from an unknown male who indicated he (unknown male) knew where Joan Webster was located.

On 10/15/82, the unknown male again called [redacted] This call was traced to a laundromat in Concord, New Hampshire. Surveillance instituted at laundromat and subsequent investigation revealed the identity of the unknown male to be [redacted]

[redacted] advised [redacted] that he had seen victim in June of 1982 and on 10/12/82. [redacted] wanted a reward of \$25,000 for information leading to the location of victim. [redacted] arranged a meeting with [redacted] for later that same day.

On 10/15/82, the meeting between [redacted] b6
[redacted] accompanied by a Special Agent of the b7C
FBI, [redacted] took place. b7E

[redacted] provided an address in Boston where
victim could be found; however, this address
proved to be erroneous.

[redacted] was subsequently interviewed by the b6
FBI. [redacted] refused to answer any questions b7C
or make any statements about this matter
during the interview.

U.S. Attorney, Boston declined prosecution
on [redacted] due to the fact no demand made and b6
no other Federal laws were violated. b7C
[redacted] is a known felon. [redacted]
was arrested in 1969 for kidnapping and
subsequently on numerous other charges.
